

## **Visit Procedures – Kintock Bridgeton II**

Rules and regulations for visiting a resident are as follows:

- Only those visitors listed on the residents' approved visiting lists will be permitted in the facility. These lists may be revised monthly upon approval from the residents' case managers. Generally, residents will be allowed only four visitors at a time unless the Deputy Director of Operations makes a specific exception. Special visiting times and arrangements may be made for those family members arriving from out of town, religious counseling, medical needs and/or legal counsel.
- Visitors must sign in, provide picture identification to staff, agree to a search of any bags brought into the facility, and sign out upon their departure.
- Visitors will not be admitted into the facility if they do not adhere to the proper dress code, i.e., no tank tops, halters, short shorts/skirts, transparent clothing, or any other items of clothing that staff deems as inappropriate.
- The spouse, companion, significant other is required to sit apart from the resident.
- Cellular phones/telecommunication devices, cameras, audio/video equipment are not permitted in the facility.
- Children under 18 years of age need to be accompanied by an adult visitor and should be closely monitored at all times by the adult visitor who is responsible.
- All visitors will be monitored by detection devices and must agree to a search of any items brought into the facility. Visitors are not permitted to bring in any type of bag, pocketbook, backpack, etc. Staff must inspect all items before they are given to a resident.
- Residents and visitors must adhere to the visiting rules posted.
- Food can only be brought in on the third weekend of every month.
- Each resident is responsible for the behavior of his visitors. Any behavior deemed inappropriate by Kintock staff will be grounds for immediate termination of the visit and sanctions against the resident responsible. Staff may also terminate visits if the area becomes overcrowded, or if other circumstances warrant clearing the area.

Visiting hours for this RCRP are as follows:

- Saturday, Sunday and Holidays: 1:00 p.m. – 4:00 p. m.
